Possible answer: Devika is as tall as a giraffe.

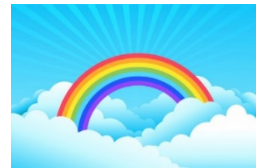
IV. Describe the nouns using suitable similes. Refer to the pictures for clues.
